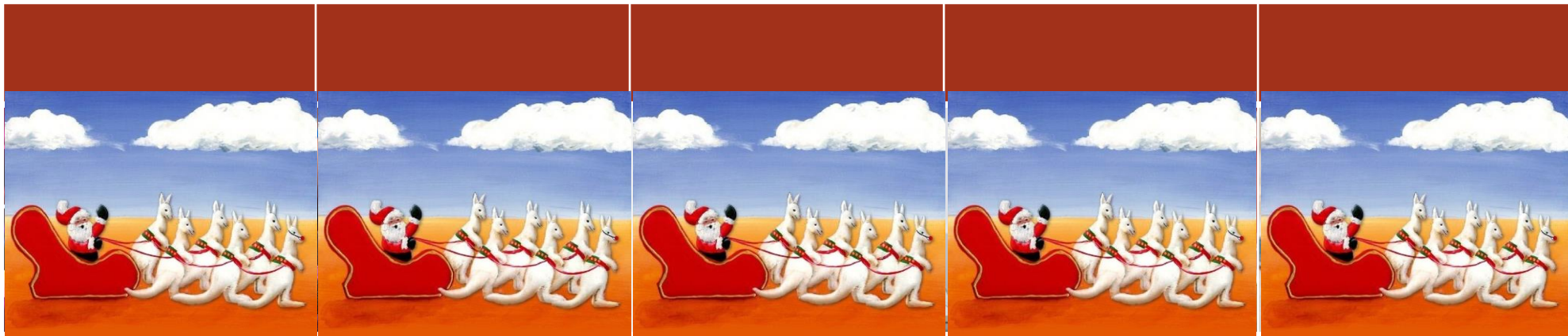
General Notes
